Overview of the IATF 16949 Standard

If your company is an automotive supplier, developing and maintaining an IATF 16949 certified Quality Management System is a requirement for this industry. And, as of June, 2017, you must start to transition to the newly released 2016 Revision. That means that the clock is ticking. You will need to convert your current documented quality system and be re-certified to the new standard by September 30, 2018.

"Change is a constant"



Companies will likely need time to adjust their processes and responsibilities to the requirements of the new standard, including *'risk-based thinking'*. During this 4 hour Overview about the requirements of the IATF 16949 Standard for the Automotive Industry, you will learn how the new standard differs from the previous TS 16949:2008 to IATF 16949:2016, which includes:

1. Authorizations added for nonconforming product and "use as is" dispositions,
2. Requirements for products with embedded software have been enhanced,
3. Products and materials regulatory conformance evidence is required for the country of manufacture and destination,
4. Requirement for a "whistle-blowing" policy,
5. Manufacturing feasibility studies that are required for new products and changes to existing products,
6. Second party audits (of external providers) which are now required.

After attending this class, participants will have a better understanding about the task required going forward to establish, document, and implement their Quality Management System to meet the requirements of the revised IATF 16949:2016 automotive standard.
