Overview of the ISO 14001:2015 Standard

"Change is Constant"

Attendees will learn about the requirements of the new standard, and for those currently registered, how these new requirements may impact their current EMS. In addition to learning about the changes, attendees will learn about how the interaction between the process approach and *'risk-based thinking'* can be applied.



Workshop will include:

1. Review of all the requirements found in sections 4-10;
2. What records 9 (retained information) are required?
3. Review of new terms being used;
4. What is a process approach;
5. The term process is mentioned 62 times: How does this impact the design of the new EMS;
6. Outputs and inputs are required 21 times: What do I do with this?
7. Reviews are recommended or required 31 times: More stuff that needs to go somewhere;
8. Some comparisons of the old standard to the new;
9. Top management's new responsibilities;
10. The new inputs into management review; and
11. What is *'Risk-based thinking'* and where must it be applied.

Upon completion of workshop, participants will:

1. Have a better understand of the Standard and how it impacts a company;
2. Be introduced to the requirements of the Standard and identify requirements for the quality manual, procedures, work instructions, and forms; and
3. Attendees will have a better understanding about the task required to establish, document, and implement their environmental management system.
4. This information will be used to establish, document, and implement the EMS.
