Critical Areas

2. Increase effectiveness of MRP/ERP
3. Mitigate global risks
4. Reduce/manage volatility
5. Expand supplier matching capabilities to source for emergent needs
6. Improve OEM/Supplier product development collaboration

Highly Important Areas

7. Document supply chain strategy
8. Align supply chain metrics with long term business focus
9. Identify and address choke points in a sustainable manner
10. Optimization of the supply chain
11. Recognize the emergent needs for future capabilities and technologies
12. Enhance value chain collaboration among suppliers, OEM's, and customers
