## Hearing Conservation Program

*"Hearing is good sense"*

This four-hour interactive workshop is designed to help participants support a system of safety improvement within their organization by teaching them a disciplined approach to hearing conservation.

It is intended as an essential guide for employees working on or around equipment noise exposures equal or exceed an 8-hour time-weighted average sound level of 85 decibels measured on the A scale or, equivalently, a dose of fifty percent." This 8-hour time-weighted average is known as an exposure action value.



Hearing conservation programs are designed to prevent noise induced hearing loss. A written hearing conservation program is required by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration "whenever employee noise exposures equal or exceed an 8-hour time-weighted average sound level of 85 decibels measured on the A scale or, equivalently, a dose of fifty percent." This 8-hour time-weighted average is known as an exposure action value.

### Upon completion of the workshop an operator will know:

- About noise induced hearing loss.
- About written hearing conversation program.
- The decibel limiters over a time-weighted average.

The company will provide the classroom and refreshments for participants and the AKA trainer.
